GROUND BREAKING FOR PISCATAWAY CRICKET FIELDS October 12, 2004

Piscataway Mayor Brian C. Wahler announced that the ground breaking for the township Cricket fields is scheduled for Tuesday, October 12, 2004 at 11:30 a.m. at the site of the proposed fields on Normandy Drive in Piscataway.

In July, 2004, Mayor Wahler announced the awarding of a New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) Livable Communities Grant for the project, "Piscataway Cricket Fields." At that Press Conference Mayor Wahler thanked State Senator Bob Smith for his help in obtaining the grant and said, "We are surely living up to the designation we received from *Sports Illustrated* magazine when Piscataway was named "Sportstown New Jersey" for our long list of outstanding recreation facilities and programs. These cricket fields will add a new and exciting dimension to recreation in Piscataway Township."
