PISCATAWAY SCHEDULES JUNE 2ND RIBBON-CUTTING IN COLUMBUS PARK

Piscataway Mayor Brian C. Wahler invites residents to a ribbon-cutting ceremony on Saturday, June 2nd, inaugurating the newest section of Columbus Park located on New Market Road in the township.

Columbus Park is the largest of the twenty six township owned parks. In addition to the new gazebo and picnic benches in the newest section, there are baseball and softball diamonds and basketball, tennis and paddleball courts. The park also features a 2,400 foot bicycle and pedestrian path. Piscataway received an award of \$7,500 from Keep Middlesex Moving (KMM) to replace worn benches and add additional benches along the path.

The event will be held from 11:30 a.m. to 1:30 p.m. There will be a DJ, a caricaturist and free refreshments.
